



Medical Volunteer (RN)

Role Overview

Medical Volunteers play a vital role in providing compassionate, professional care to patients at ABC Women's Center. Licensed Registered Nurses support our medical services by conducting pregnancy tests, assisting with ultrasound appointments, and offering medically accurate education in a respectful, supportive environment.

This role allows medical professionals to use their training to serve women and families during a critical moment in their lives.

What Medical Volunteers Do

Medical Volunteers (RNs) support patient care by:

- Performing scheduled pregnancy urine tests
- Providing medically accurate education about pregnancy, fetal development, and available options
- Assisting with ultrasound appointments alongside the Sonographer, when scheduled
- Reviewing medical history forms to determine ultrasound eligibility
- Helping coordinate and schedule ultrasound appointments when appropriate
- Working collaboratively with Client Advocates and medical staff during appointments
- Offering clear, compassionate explanations to patients regarding each step of care
- Maintaining accurate and thorough patient documentation in the medical record system

Ultrasound Support

Medical Volunteers may be scheduled to:

- Accompany the Sonographer during ultrasound appointments
- Support best medical practice by ensuring appropriate staffing during clinic hours
- Assist in patient flow and education surrounding ultrasound services

Time Commitment

- Shifts are scheduled based on clinic needs and volunteer availability
- Consistency is encouraged to support continuity of care
- Scheduling is coordinated with the Executive Director

Training & Requirements

To serve in this role, Medical Volunteers must:

- Hold an active **Registered Nurse (RN) license in the state of Connecticut**
- Complete ABC Women's Center's volunteer application and screening process
- Receive training provided by the Medical Services Manager
- Uphold ABC's medical protocols, policies, and confidentiality standards
- Commit to providing professional, compassionate, and ethical medical care
